THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 5) 1957.

Order made under Regulation 38 (i).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 38 (i) of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1957, I, Bertram John Weston, Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia, do hereby order as follows :—

I. This Order may be cited as the Protected Areas (Nicosia District No. 1) Order, 1958.

2. The area specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a Protected Area for the purposes of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1957.

SCHEDULE.

The area of and adjacent to the Central Prison, Nicosia, comprising plots I and 2 of Block B of Arab Ahmed Quarter and plots I, 46, 47, 60 and 61 of Block B of Ayios Andreas Quarter and including that part of Norman Street lying to the west of its junction with Rupel Street and Korytsa and Macedonia Street for a distance of one hundred and thirty feet southwards from their junction with Norman Street.

THE DEFENCE (IMPORTATION OF GOODS) REGULATIONS, 1956.

Notice (No. 22) under Clause 3 of the First Schedule.

" (c) that shipment of such goods will be made not later than the 15th September, 1958, and the goods shall be cleared from Customs on or before the 15th December, 1958 ".
