THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 5) 1957.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

Whereas it appears to the Governor to be expedient in the interest of public order and safety to take possession of the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") and to authorise its use in the interest of public order and safety :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1957. His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to take possession of the land and, in connection with the taking possession and making use of the land, has been pleased to direct and order as follows :-

- (1) The use of the land for the requirements of Her Majesty's Forces is hereby authorised.
- (2) The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are hereby authorised to do, in relation to the land, anything which any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of that interest.
- (3) The exercise of any right of way over the land, and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited.

SCHEDULE.

All that area of privately owned land under parts of plots 4/19 and 4/20 of the Government Survey Plan No. LIV. 59.I.I. of Ayios Nicolaos Quarter, Limassol, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Commissioner, Limassol, and dated the 13th of July, 1956.

No. 291. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952, 43 OF 1955 AND 22 OF 1956.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Notification No. 107 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 16th February, 1956, the Governor declared the widening, improving and realigning of the public road between Nicosia and Limassol to be an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Commissioner of Larnaca in compliance with section 6 of the Land Acquisition Law, by a notice published under Notification No. 148

in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 27th February, 1958, gave particulars of a portion of the lands required in connection with the aforesaid undertaking (hereinafter referred to as "the lands");

And whereas the Commissioner of Larnaca forwarded to the Governor the required recommendations, plan and particulars, no objections having been made;

And whereas the Governor has approved the plan and particulars submitted, and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the lands be acquired:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, the Governor hereby sanctions the acquisition of the lands under the provisions of the said Law.

No. 292. THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.
LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District No. 2) Order, 1958.

2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 17th day of April, 1958.
