ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 11th December, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 13th December, 1956, under Notification No. 1224 (as amended by Notification No. 256 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 17th April, 1958, (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the village areas of Kalopsidha, Makrasyka and Akhna in the Famagusta District and Xylotymbou and Pyla in the Larnaca District (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;
