No. 435. THE ASSEMBLIES AND PROCESSIONS LAW, 1958.
(**LAW No. 7 OF 1958.**)

ORDER UNDER PARAGRAPH (a) OF SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION 5 AND
UNDER SUB-SECTION (2) OF SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section 5 and by sub-section (2) of section 9 of the Assemblies and Processions Law, 1958, I, the Governor, hereby make the following Order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Assemblies and Processions (Emergency Provisions) Order, 1958.

2. In this Order "the Law" means the Assemblies and Processions Law, 1958.

3.—(1) The holding of any assembly or procession in any place, not being a public place, in any part of the Colony is hereby prohibited.

(2) In this paragraph "assembly" means any celebration, ceremony or any public gathering whatsoever, not being exempted from the operation of any part of the Law by sub-section (1) of section 9 thereof, but does not include :—

- (a) any assembly in a cinema only for the purposes of presentation of a cinematograph film approved for presentation and exhibition under the provisions of the Cinematograph Films Law ;
- (b) any assembly in the ordinary course of business of a restaurant, café or cabaret ;
- (c) any press conference, or meeting of a trade union, or any professional, trade, commercial, or administrative body of persons meeting for the transaction of business or the discussion of matters in which such persons have a *bona fide* interest.

4. The following assemblies are hereby exempted from section 4 of the Assemblies and Processions Law :—

- (a) assemblies in the ordinary course of business of open air restaurants, open air cafés and open air cabarets ;
- (b) assemblies in open air cinemas only for the purposes of the presentation and exhibition of cinematograph films approved for presentation and exhibition under the provisions of the Cinematograph Films Law.

5. The Assemblies and Processions (Prohibition) (Places not being Public Places) Order, 1958, and the Assemblies and Processions (Prohibition) (Places not being Public Places) (Amendment) Order, 1958, are hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.
