# THE EXCHANGE CONTROL LAWS, 1952 TO 1957.

DIRECTION REGULATING THE USE OF HONG KONG ASSETS IN CYPRUS.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 38A of the Exchange Control Laws, 1952 to 1957, His Excellency the Governor hereby gives the following direction:

Except with permission granted by or on behalf of the Financial Secretary, no order given by or on behalf of any person resident in Hong Kong on or after the date of this direction may be carried out, in so far as the order—

(i) requires the person to whom the order is given to make any payment or to part with any securities; or

(ii) requires any change to be made in the persons to whose credit any sum is to be paid or to whose order any securities are to be held.
