THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 3) 1958.

### ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 38.

- I, the Commissioner of Nicosia, in exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (1) of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1958, do hereby order as follows:—
- 1. This Order may be cited as the Protected Areas (Nicosia District No. 4) Order, 1958.
- 2. The area specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a protected area for the purpose of Regulation 38 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1958.
- 3. This Order shall come into force at 1215 hours on the 28th day of July, 1958, and shall remain in force until further notice.

#### SCHEDULE.

Airport Road, Nicosia, from the Main Gate, R.A.F., Nicosia, to a point 50 yards eastwards.

# THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 3) 1958.

### ORDER UNDER REGULATION 34.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by paragraph (b) of Regulation 34 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1958, I, the Commissioner of Paphos, do hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Paphos District (Control of Pedal Cycles) (No. 1) Order, 1958.
- 2. The use or circulation of any pedal cycle within the area set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby prohibited except under the authority of a written permit granted by me or by the officer in charge of Paphos Police Division:

  Provided that this paragraph shall not apply to:—

(a) members of Her Majesty's Forces;

- (b) members of the Cyprus Police Force (as defined in the Police Law) when on duty as such;
- (c) males over the age of 27 years.
- 3. No pedal cycle shall be left in any road or any place to which the public have access in the area specified in the Schedule hereto.
