ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District No. 21) Order, 1958.

2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 7th day of July, 1958.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

The area in Omorphita bounded on the North by Omorphita Bye-Pass, on the South by, Truman Street and Kaimakli Street, on the West by, Serrae Street and on the East by Queen Elizabeth Street.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

From 1900 hours until 0430 hours nightly until further notice.

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 9th day of July, 1958.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

That part of the old city of Nicosia bounded by the following streets : Athena Avenue, Barbaros Street, Attila Street, Devedjiler Street, Kara Buba A Street, Baki Effendi Street, Hermes Street, Orhaniye Street, Theseus Street, Phokas Avenue.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

From 1600 hours to 1930 hours on 9th July, 1958.
