THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 3) 1958.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

Whereas it appears to the Governor to be expedient in the interest of public order and safety to take possession of the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") and to authorise its use in the interest of public order and safety :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1958, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to take possession of the land and, in connection with the taking possession and making use of the land, has been pleased to direct and order as follows :—

- (1) The use of the land for the requirements of the Police is hereby authorised.
- (2) The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are hereby authorised to do, in relation to the land, anything which any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of that interest.
- (3) The exercise of any right of way over the land, and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited.

SCHEDULE.

All those privately owned premises comprising two semi-detached two storied houses and adjoining land, under plots 62 and 63 of the Government Survey plan of Nicosia (Ibrahim Pasha Qr.) XXI.38.6.II, Block B, more particularly defined as the area coloured blue on the plan signed by the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia, dated the 9th August, 1958, and deposited in his Office at Nicosia.
