THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 2) 1958.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

Whereas it appears to the Governor to be expedient in the interest of public order and safety to take possession of the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") and to authorise its use in the interest of public order and safety:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 2) 1958, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to take possession of the land and, in connection with the taking possession and making use of the land, has been pleased to direct and order as follows:—

(1) The use of the land for the requirements of Her Majesty's Forces

is hereby authorized.

(2) The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are hereby authorised to do, in relation to the land, anything which any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of that interest.

(3) The exercise of any right of way over the land, and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited.

The area appearing in Government Survey Plan under plot Nos. 765, 766, 774, 775, 788, 789, 790, 791, 792, 793, 794, 795, 796, 797, 798, 799, 800, 801, 802, 803, 804, 805 and 806 and parts of plots Nos. 767, 773, 101, 165, 104 and 103 of Block C and under plot No. 9 of Block A, all of Ayios Loukas Quarter of Famagusta Town, as more particularly defined as the area delineated in red on the plan signed by the Commissioner Famagusta and dated the 11th August, 1958, and filed with Commissioner, Famagusta.
