## No. 691. THE DEFENCE (IMPORTATION OF GOODS) REGULATIONS, 1956.

### OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE No. 19.999.

Gazettes: Supplement No. 3: 10. 5.56. 8.11.56. In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of the Defence (Importation of Goods) Regulations, 1956, I hereby grant to any importer registered under the provisions of the Defence (Registration of Importers) Order, 1956, an Open General Import Licence under No. 19.999 to import into the Colony in any quantity any of the goods enumerated in the Schedule hereto and originating in any of the following countries and exported from such country of origin :—

- (a) Australia, Ghana, Federation of Malaya, New Zealand, Union of South Africa, India, Pakistan, Ceylon, Eire;
- (b) Austria, Belgium (including overseas dependent territories), Burma, Denmark, Finland, France (including overseas dependent territories), Greece, Western Germany, Iceland, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands (including overseas dependent territories), Norway, Portugal (including overseas dependent territories), Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and Turkey;
- (c) Bahrein, Egypt, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Iran, Iraq, Israel, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libya, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, Syria :

Provided that in all cases covered by this licence payment for the goods shall be made, through banking channels, either—

- (i) in sterling; or
- (ii) in the case of goods imported from a country whose currency
- is specified under the Exchange Control (Specified Currency) Order, 1957, or any Order amending or replacing the same, in the currency of such country.

2. This Open General Import Licence is deemed to be a written licence issued by me under regulation 3(1)(a) of the Defence (Importation of Goods) Regulations, 1956, and is subject to the provisions of regulation 3(1)(b) of the said Regulations.

3. The Open General Import Licence No. 8000 published under Notification No. 412 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 11th April, 1957, as amended under Notifications Nos. 527 and 607, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazettes* of 16th May and 14th June, 1957, respectively, is hereby cancelled without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

(This Note is not part of the Licence but it is intended to explain its general purport.)

This Open General Import Licence replaces Licence No. 8000 from which it differs in so far as :---

- (a) certain new items have been included ;
- (b) certain goods have been excluded or more closely specified ;
- (c) Burma, the Federation of Malaya, Finland and Ghana have been added to the countries to which the licence applies ; and
- (d) the Second Schedule has been omitted.

The import of many goods included in the Open General Import Licence is subject to a permit under the hand of the Director of Agriculture or other appropriate Authority, as the case may be. The fact that any such goods are included in this Open General Import Licence does not mean that import will be permitted unless the importer holds the necessary permit from the appropriate Authority.
