

No. 692.**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 3) 1958.****AUTHORIZATION UNDER REGULATION 44.**

Whereas it appears to the Governor to be expedient in the interest of public order and safety that he should take possession of the lands hereinafter described :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (1) of Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1958, the Governor hereby takes possession of the lands described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the lands") and, in connection with the taking possession of the lands, directs as follows :—

1. The exercise of any right of way over the lands and of any other right relating thereto which was hitherto enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited;
2. The lands shall be set aside for the use of the Cyprus Police Force ; and
3. The persons using the lands in pursuance of these directions are hereby authorized to do, in relation to the lands, anything which any person hitherto having an interest in the land would have been entitled to do by virtue of that interest.

SCHEDULE.

All that privately-owned property situated in Ktima Town, Paphos District, known as the Paphos Palace Hotel, comprising lands, buildings and all appurtenances thereto held under plot No. 1290 of the Government Survey Plan LI.3.4.XIII and more particularly defined as the area coloured yellow on the plan signed by the Commissioner of Paphos and dated 13th August, 1958, a copy of which is available for inspection at the office of the Commissioner of Paphos.
