ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 3 (1).

No. 695. THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 3) 1958.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

Whereas it appears to the Governor to be necessary in the interest of public safety and order to take possession of the land described in the Schedule to this Order:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1958, notice is hereby given that the Governor has taken possession of all the land specified in the Schedule hereto.

Any member of Her Majesty's Forces is hereby authorised to do in relation to the land anything which the owner or any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of such ownership or interest, as may be necessary for security purposes.

The exercise of any right relating to the land which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this order shall remain in force.
