CAP. 165 AND LAWS 10 OF 1950, 44 OF 1954, 18 OF 1955 AND 12 OF 1957.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17 (7).

With reference to the notice published under No. 348 in the *Gazette* of 14th March, 1957, as amended by notice No. 286 published in the *Gazette* of 6th March, 1958, it is hereby notified for general information that, after considering the plans and specifications concerning the streets shewn under column (1) of the Schedule hereto and objections made, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to approve the plans and specifications concerning the said streets to the extent shown under column (2) of the Schedule hereto.

2. The plans and specifications in respect of the streets set out in the Schedule hereto shall, subject to the condition shown under column (2) of the Schedule, be binding on the Municipal Council of Famagusta and upon all owners affected.
