THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1939 AND 1956.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 6.

HUGH FOOT, Governor.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations:-

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Municipal Taxes, Fees, etc.) Regulations, 1958.
- (2) The Interpretation Law shall apply to the interpretation of these Cap. 1. Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Law, and, for the purposes of the said Law, these Regulations shall be deemed to be Laws.

19 of 1956. 2. Notwithstanding anything in the Municipal Corporations Law or in any other Law contained, no proceedings, civil or criminal, shall be instituted in any Court in Cyprus established by or under any Order of Her 20 of 1953 Majesty in Council or any Cyprus Law, without the leave of the Governor, 29 of 1954 for the recovery of, or otherwise in respect of, any rates, fees, rents, tolls 57 of 1954 or other charges payable to or any property belonging to a Municipal 14 of 1955. Corporation constituted under the aforesaid Municipal Corporations Law.

3. Any such proceedings instituted before the coming into operation of these Regulations shall be deemed to abate and shall not be further proceeded with except by leave of the Governor.
