3. Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Exe-

cutive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

4. And provided that this Order shall not apply to any person who is not a Greek Cypriot male or female born on or after 1st January, 1933, and before 1st January, 1946.
