

2. The owners and occupiers of the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), and the agents of such owners and occupiers, are hereby directed :—

- (a) to cut and clear away from the land all herbage, bush and undergrowth ;
- (b) to prevent any herbage, bush or undergrowth on the land from growing higher than one foot and to maintain the land in a clear condition to the satisfaction of the Area Commander, Nicosia ;
- (c) to cut flush with the trunk and clear away the branches of all Cypress trees standing on the land to a height of twelve feet from the ground level, and of all fruit trees to a height of six feet from ground level ; and
- (d) to cut and clear away all Eucalyptus and Acacia trees or branches thereof save as may be exempted by the Area Commander, Nicosia.

SCHEDULE.

The area of land abutting on or lying within a distance of fifty yards of the following sections of public roads :—

1. Delphi Street, and its continuation southwards, from its junction with Achaeans Street to its junction with Archangel Michael Street.
2. Trunk Road A (Kykko Bye-Pass) from Pedieos River westward to the roundabout at its junction with the main road from Nicosia Airport to Ayios Dhometios.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 60 (A).

Whereas I consider it expedient in the interests of Public Safety to make a clearance order in respect of the land described in the Schedule hereto :—

Now, therefore, I, the Commissioner of Nicosia, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 60A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1958, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Clearance) (Nicosia District) (No. 3) Order, 1958.
2. The owners and occupiers of the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), and the agents of such owners and occupiers, are hereby directed :—
  - (a) to cut and clear away from the land all herbage, bush and undergrowth ;
  - (b) to prevent any herbage, bush or undergrowth on the land from growing higher than one foot and to maintain the land in a clear condition to the satisfaction of the Area Commander, Nicosia ;
  - (c) to cut flush with the trunk and clear away the branches of all Cypress trees standing on the land to a height of twelve feet from the ground level, and of all fruit trees to a height of six feet from ground level ; and

1. The main road from Nicosia to Agros through Palekhori from the 9th milestone to the District boundary.
2. From the main Nicosia-Agros road at the 17th milestone southwards through Kalochorio to Gourri, thence south-eastwards through Lazania to Makheras monastery.
3. The main road from Malounda to Eliophotes through Mitsero and Agrokipia villages as far as Eliophotes.

## ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 63A.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 63A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955, to (No. 2) 1958, I, the Commissioner of Larnaca, do hereby make the following order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibition of Sound Signals (Larnaca District) (No. 3) Order, 1958.
2. Subject to the provisions of paragraph 3 of this Order, the sounding of sirens, hooters or any form of sound signal within the area set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby prohibited.
3. The provisions of paragraph 2 of this Order shall not apply :—
  - (a) to sirens, hooters or any form of sound signal used by the Cyprus Police Force or members of Her Majesty's Forces, the use of which is authorised by me ;
  - (b) to horns used on motor vehicles.
