Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

This Order shall come into force on the 6th day of October, 1958.

No Greek Cypriots, male or female born between 1st January, 1932, and 1st January, 1944, within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Paphos or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, the Cyprus Police Force, or other

than Greek Cypriots.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 9th October, 1958.
