No Greek Cypriot male or female within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto, except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Larnaca or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, the Cyprus Police Force on duty, or persons holding a summons to appear before a Special Court, established under the Special Courts Laws, 1955 to 1957, when proceeding to and from such Court

in accordance with such summons.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 13th day of October, 1958.
