In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Paphos District) (No. 50)

Order, 1958.

2. No Turkish Cypriot, within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Paphos or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Exe-

cutive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 18th day of October, 1958.

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Paphos District) (No. 51)

Order, 1958.

2. No Greek Cypriots, male and female born between 1st January, 1932, and 1st January, 1944, within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Paphos or the Superintendent of Police in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, the Cyprus Police Force or to other than

Greek Cypriots.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 20th day of October, 1958, and is in addition to and not an abrogation of the Order No. 48.

Within the Town boundaries of Ktima and Kato Paphos.

From 1530 hours on the 20th October, 1958, until further notice.
