## ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District) (No. 65A) Order, 1958.
- 2. No person within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces or the Cyprus Police Force, or persons holding a summons to appear before a Special Court, established under the Special Court Laws, 1955 to 1957, when proceeding to and from such Court in accordance with such summons.

This Order shall come into force on the 23rd day of October, 1958.

## ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District) (No. 66) Order, 1958.
- 2. No Greek Cypriot male or female shall be out of doors within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto, between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule, except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, the Cyprus Police Force on duty, or persons holding a summons to appear before a Special Court, established under the Special Court Laws, 1955 to 1957, when proceeding to and from such Court in accordance with such summons.

3. This Order shall come into force at 0925 hours on the 24th October, 1958,
