THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.

Laws 17 and 47 of 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666, published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Nicosia District) (No. 68) Order, 1958.
- 2. No Greek Cypriot male or female born between the 1st January, 1932, and the 1st January, 1944, both dates inclusive, shall be out of doors within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto, except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Nicosia or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area:

Provided this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, the Cyprus Police Force on duty, persons holding a summons to appear before a Special Court, established under the Special Court Laws, 1955 to 1957, when proceeding to and from such Court in accordance with such summons.

3. This Order shall come into force at 1700 hours on the 5th November, 1958.

## FIRST SCHEDULE.

The Municipal area of Nicosia and the Improvement Board areas of Strovolos, Ayios Dhometios, Kaimakli and Palouriotissa, the Village areas of Trakhonas, Omorphita, Engomi, Orta Keuy and Eylenja.

## SECOND SCHEDULE.

From 1700 hours on the 5th November, 1958 to 0500 hours on the 6th November, 1958, and thence nightly until further notice.
