THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 5) 1957.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

Whereas it appears to the Governor to be expedient in the interest of public order and safety to take possession of the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") and to authorize its use in the interest of public order and safety :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1957, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to take possession of the land and, in connection with the taking possession and making use of the land, has been pleased to direct and order as follows :—

- (1) The use of the land for the requirements of Her Majesty's Forces is hereby authorized.
- (2) The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are hereby authorized to do, in relation to the land, anything which any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of that interest.
- (3) The exercise of any right of way over the land, and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited.

2. The Order dated 28th November, 1956, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 3rd January, 1957, under Notification No. 29 (as renewed by the extending Orders dated the 18th February, 1957, and the 18th August, 1957) is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE.

All that privately owned property situated in Pano Platres, Limassol District, known as the Magic Garden coffee shop, comprising land, buildings and all appurtenances thereto under Plot Nos. 121 and 317/3 of the Government Survey Plan XLVII.II.E.I.E. and more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the Plan signed by the Commissioner of Limassol and dated 28th November, 1956, a copy of which is available for inspection at the Office of the Commissioner of Troodos at Platres.

THE REGISTRATION OF RESIDENTS LAW, 1957.
(LAW No. 31 OF 1957.)

RULES MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER PARAGRAPH (C) OF SUB-SECTION (2)
OF SECTION 5 AND UNDER SECTION 21.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (c) of sub-section 2 of section 5 and section 21 of the Registration of Residents Law, 1957, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make the following rules.

1. These rules may be cited as the Registration of Residents (Amendment) Rules, 1958, and shall be read as one with the Registration of Residents Rules, 1957 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal rules") and the principal rules and these rules may together be cited as the Registration of Residents Rules, 1957 and 1958.

2. Rule 5 of the principal rules is hereby amended by substituting a semi-colon for the full-stop at the end of paragraph (d) thereof and by inserting thereafter the following new paragraph to be lettered "(e)"—

"(e) the wife and child, under the age of 18 years, of persons exempted under paragraph (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Law if such wife and such child are in possession of a document of identity issued by the Government of Cyprus."

No. 95. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952, 43 OF 1955 AND 22 OF 1956.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Notification No. 107 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 16th February, 1956, the Governor declared the widening, improving and realigning of the public road between Nicosia and Limassol to be an undertaking of public utility ;

And whereas the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia in compliance with section 6 of the Land Acquisition Law by a notice published under Notification No. 1089 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th December, 1957, gave particulars of a portion of the lands required in connection with the aforesaid undertaking (hereinafter referred to as "the lands") ;

And whereas the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia forwarded to the Governor the required recommendations, plan and particulars, no objections having been made ;

And whereas the Governor has approved the plan and particulars submitted, and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the lands be acquired :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, the Governor hereby sanctions the acquisition of the lands under the provisions of the said Law.
