

No. 964. THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 8th February, 1957, and published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 14th February, 1957, under Notification No. 123 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in the village of Kato Lakatamia (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months ;

And whereas by virtue of Notifications Nos. 747 and 62 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazettes* of the 1st August, 1957 and 6th February, 1958, respectively, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 7th August, 1958 ;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1957), His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use of the said land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order for a further period of six months as from the 8th August, 1958.

**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 5) 1958.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 39A.

Whereas I, the Commissioner of the District of Famagusta, am satisfied that the buildings described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the buildings") is a building which is being used by terrorists, now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 39A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1958, with the approval of the Governor do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Forfeiture and Demolition) (Famagusta District) (No. 12) Order, 1958, and shall come into force on the 21st October, 1958.

2. It is hereby directed that the building and its contents be forfeited and demolished.

SCHEDULE.

(i) The house under registration No. 4699 situated at Varosha, Famagusta, and standing under plot No. 264 of the Government Survey Plan XXXIII/20.3.II and Block F.

(ii) The house under registration No. 3196 situated at Varosha, Famagusta, and standing under plot No. 261 of the Government Survey Plan XXXIII/20.3.II and Block F.

**THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 5) 1958.**

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 39A.

Whereas I, the Commissioner of the District of Famagusta, am satisfied that the building described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the building") is a building which is being used by terrorists, now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 39A of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 5) 1958, with the approval of the Governor, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Forfeiture and Demolition) (Famagusta District) (No. 13) Order, 1958, and shall come into force on the 30th October, 1958.

2. It is hereby directed that the building and its contents be forfeited and demolished.
