## THE CUSTOMS MANAGEMENT LAWS, 1954 TO 1959.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3068

## MADE UNDER SECTION 42.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 42 of the Customs 8 of 1954 Management Laws, 1954 to 1959, His Excellency the Governor, with 49 of 1955 the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Order : \_\_\_\_\_\_ 7 of 1959.

I. This Order may be cited as the Customs Management (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) (Amendment) Order, 1959, and shall be read as one with the Customs Management (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) Order, 1958, as from time to time amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Customs Management (Prohibition and Restriction of Imports) Orders, 1958 and 1959.

2. The Third Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following further item to be numbered "5":--

"5. Appliances capable of use for filling shot gun cartridges."
