THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 12th October, 1956, and published under Public Instrument No. 984 of 1956 (as amended by Public Instrument No. 57 of 1957) (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated in Larnaca Town (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;

And whereas by virtue of Public Instruments Nos. 399 of 1957, 901 of 1957, 214 of 1958 and 1017 of 1958, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 11th April, 1959.

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1958), His Excellency the Governor has authorised the use of the said land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order for a further period of six months as from the 12th April, 1959.
