

THE POST OFFICE LAW.
CAP. 281.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3073

MADE UNDER SECTION 7.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 7 of the Post Office Law, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, makes the Order following :—

Cap. 281
44 of 1953.

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Parcel Post Rates) Order, 1959.

2. There shall be charged a combined Postage and Air fee at the rate set forth in the third column of the Schedule hereto in respect of air parcels posted in the Colony and intended for transmission by air mail to any of the countries of destination set forth in the first column of the said Schedule, through the route set forth in the second column thereof opposite each country.

3. The Post Office (Air Parcel Post Rates) Order, 1957 is hereby revoked.
