THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 10th November, 1955 and published under Public Instrument No. 714 of 1955 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated at Katholiki Quarter, Limassol town (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;

And whereas by virtue of Public Instruments Nos. 334 of 1956, 1164 of 1956, 496 of 1957, 963 of 1957, 305 of 1958 and 879 of 1958, the Order was extended for further periods of six months up to the 9th May, 1959;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months:
