## THE CUSTOMS (WHARFAGE DUES) LAW, 1955.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3077

MADE UNDER SECTION 5.

10 of 1955. In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 5 of the Customs (Wharfage Dues) Law, 1955, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Wharfage Dues) (Revision) (Amendment) Order, 1959, and shall be read as one with the Customs (Wharfage Dues) (Revision) Orders, 1955 to 1958 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Customs (Wharfage Dues) (Revision) Orders, 1955 to 1959.

2. The part of the principal Order headed "(A) WHARFAGE DUES FOR IMPORTS" is hereby amended in manner following :—

(a) by the deletion of Item 2 thereof and the substitution thereof of the following :—

<i>Item No.</i>	<i>Description of Goods.</i>	<i>Rate.</i>
2	Animal feeding stuffs including vetches and unmilled cereals (including wheat, barley and maize).	100 mils per ton or part thereof."

(b) by the deletion of Item 13 thereof.

**No. 280. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAW.**

CAP. 252 AND LAWS 11 OF 1950, 31 OF 1951, 20 OF 1953, 29 OF 1954, 57 OF 1954 AND 14 OF 1955.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3078

MADE UNDER SECTION 124 (1).

*Authority to the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta to contract a loan.*

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 124 (1) of the Municipal Corporations Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. The Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Councillors and Townsmen of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta (hereinafter referred to as "the Municipal Corporation") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Bank of Cyprus Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the Lender") the sum of fifteen thousand pounds

(£15,000) at a rate of interest not exceeding six per centum (6%) per annum, subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say :—

- (a) the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Municipal Corporation to the Lender in eleven equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest), the first instalment being payable one year after the date of borrowing and all subsequent instalments being payable on the corresponding date of each year following until final repayment ;
- (b) the Municipal Corporation shall, in each year and until final repayment of the sum borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on its revenues the annual sum payable as aforesaid in the year to which such estimates relate ;
- (c) the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Municipal Corporation for the construction, reconstruction and improvement of streets within the municipal limits of Famagusta.

2. For the purpose of securing the repayment of the sum under the loan, the Municipal Corporation is hereby authorized, subject to any prior mortgage thereon, to mortgage to the Lender all the rates, fees and duties now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Municipal Corporation.
