Bye-laws made by the Improvement Board of Palouriotissa.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by sections 21 and 24 of the 12 of 1950 Villages (Administration and Improvement) Laws, 1950 and 1953, the Im- 18 of 1950 provement Board of Palouriotissa, hereby make the following bye-laws: ---

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Villages (Administration and P.I. Improvement) Palouriotissa Bye-laws, 1959, and shall be read as one with the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Bye-laws, 1951 and 1957 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws"), and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Villages (Administration and Improvement) Palouriotissa Bye-laws, 1951 to 1959.

2. Bye-law 26 of the principal Bye-laws is hereby repealed and the following bye-law substituted therefor: --

"26. Fees on the following scale shall be paid by the person bringing the respective animal for slaughter in the appropriate slaughter-house:
