2. The plans and specifications in respect of the streets set out in the Schedule hereto shall, subject to the conditions shown under column (2) of the Schedule, be binding on the Municipal Council of Famagusta and upon all owners affected.

No. 362. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAW.
CAP. 142.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF OMORPHITA
UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, Cap. 142, the Village Health Commission of Omorphita hereby make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Village Health (Omorphita) (Amendment) Rules, 1959, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Omorphita) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules") and the principal Rules and these Rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Omorphita) Rules, 1938 and 1959.

2. Rule 20 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and substituted by the following Rule:—

"Rule 20 (i).—The following fees shall be paid by the owner of, or the person slaughtering, any animal in a slaughter-house, that is to say:—

	<i>Mils</i>
(a) For every bullock, camel, cow or ox for each oke or part thereof	10
(b) For every goat, kid, lamb or sheep not exceeding 6 okes in weight	100
(c) For every goat, kid, lamb or sheep exceeding 6 okes in weight	150
(d) For every swine for each oke or part thereof	13
(ii) Weight in this Rule means the weight of the carcass after it is dressed, skinned and cleared."	

The above Rules have been approved by the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia.
