## NOTICE UNDER SECTION 44.

## THE IRRIGATION (PRIVATE WATER) ASSOCIATION LAW.

LAWS NO. 26 OF 1949 AND 34 OF 1954

AND

THE IRRIGATION ASSOCIATION OF POTAMIA  
("PORTALOMO" WATER).DISSOLUTION OF THE IRRIGATION ASSOCIATION OF POTAMIA  
("PORTALOMO" WATER).

Whereas an application was made to the Commissioner of Nicosia signed by not less than two-thirds of the proprietors requesting that the Irrigation Association of Potamia ("Portalomo" Water) (hereinafter referred to as the "Association") be dissolved;

And whereas at a meeting of the proprietors of the Association held under Rule 18 of the Irrigation Association of Potamia ("Portalomo" Water) Rules 1953 (hereinafter referred to as the "Rules") at the village of Potamia on the 5th July, 1959, it was unanimously decided by the voters present thereat that the said Association should be dissolved:

Now, therefore, it is hereby notified that the Association has been dissolved accordingly as from the 5th July, 1959, subject to the reservations and exceptions contained in the Rules.
