And whereas the Commissioner of Larnaca by a notice published under Public Instrument No. 337 of 1959 gave particulars of the properties (hereinafter referred to as "the properties") required in connection with the aforesaid undertaking;

And whereas the Commissioner of Larnaca forwarded to the Governor the required recommendations, plans and particulars together with a report that no objections have been made;

And whereas the Governor has approved the plans and particulars submitted, and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the properties be acquired :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, the Governor hereby sanctions the acquisition of the properties under the provisions of the said Law.
