THE PENSIONS LAW. CAP. 288.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3 of the Cap. 288. Pensions Law, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council and with the sanction of the Secretary of State, hereby makes the regulations following: —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Pensions (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1959, and shall be read as one with the Pensions Regulations as from time to time amended (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations ").

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by inserting immediately after Regulation 23A the Regulation following: -

Addition of new regulation 23B.

"Service in the English School by persons not teachers.

23B. Notwithstanding anything in these Regulations contained, when a person who, having served in a full time capacity as the bursar or as a clerk or as the matron in the English School employed by the Board of Management of the said school, is appointed without any break to the serviceof the Government, any period of service as such bursar or clerk or matron as the case may be shall be taken into account for the purposes of these Regulations.".

3. The Appendix to the principal Regulations is hereby amended by Amendment inserting therein at the appropriate place so that the items shall be in alphabetical order the new item following: -

"West Indies (Federation)".
