## No. 449. THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW.

CAP. 92 AND LAWS 16 OF 1954 AND 21 OF 1957.

## NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 (1) of the Foreshore Protection Law, I hereby absolutely prohibit :

- (a) the removal of stones, shingle, gravel, sand or other substance from all that area of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto ;
- (b) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse upon any part of the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto ;
- (c) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweepings, litter, night-soil or other refuse into the sea at any point opposite to the foreshore described in the Schedule hereto within a distance of 200 yards from low water mark.

2. Public Instrument No. 325 of 1954, is hereby cancelled without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

## SCHEDULE.

*Vasilia Village.*

The foreshore commences at the mouth of the River of Ayios Yeoryios and proceeds in an easterly direction along the high water mark to the mouth of the River of Stipia, and includes any land within a distance of fifty yards of the said high water mark throughout its length. The said foreshore is more particularly defined as the area coloured yellow on the Government Survey Plan, Serial No. 1695 a copy of which is available for inspection at the Office of the Commissioner at Kyrenia.
