**THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) REGULATIONS,
1956 AND 1958.**

NOTICE UNDER REGULATIONS 20 (b) AND 131.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulations 20 (b) and 131 P.I. of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Regulations, 1956 and 1958, I, the Director of Commerce and Industry do hereby direct as follows :— 47/1956
141/1958.

SULTANA RAISINS.

All sultana raisins intended for export shall :—

- (a) contain not more than fifteen per cent. by weight of moisture ;
- (b) show no signs of fermentation ;
- (c) not be infested or show signs of infestation by insect pests or diseases ;
- (d) contain no foreign or extraneous matter ;
- (e) contain not more than ten per cent by number of raisins from which the pedicels have not been removed ;
- (f) contain raisins of not more than one crop or any raisins of variety other than that known locally as " sultanina " ;
- (g) be of uniform size.
