In exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 2 and 3 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to prescribe that the periods specified in the Schedule hereto shall be a close season in addition to the close season as defined in section 2 of the Law.

SCHEDULE.

- 1. The period between 1st October, 1959, and 24th October, 1959, both days inclusive.
- 2. The period between the 18th of January, 1960, and 31st January, 1960, both days inclusive.
- 3. All days in the week during a non-close season except Wednesdays and Sundays, and the 24th and 26th December, 1959, and the 2nd January, 1960.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 5.

Cap. 98. 23 of 1950 3 of 1953 57 of 1955. In exercise of the powers vested in him by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section 5 of the Game and Wild Birds Protection Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order that during the period preceding the 31st day of July, 1960, every holder of a game licence shall kill or cause to be killed six crows or magpies or three ravens or one fox, or pay five hundred mils for every crow or magpie short of such number or £1 for every raven short of three or £3 if no fox or any of the other vermin is killed.
