# THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force in consequence of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1957), His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order as follows:—

- 1. Subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the use, for military purposes, of the land and property specified in the Second Schedule (hereinafter referred to as "the land") during the period of six months is authorized from the 19th day of August, 1959.
- 2. The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for such military purposes.
- 3. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE.

- 1. The land shall be occupied and used for military purposes only.
- 2. At the expiration of this Order the land shall be restored to the persons entitled thereto free of any erection, structure or construction erected or constructed thereon after the making of this Order.
- 3. Compensation shall be paid to the persons having an interest on the land for its use and occupation under this Order.

## SECOND SCHEDULE.

The privately owned land situated in Yerolakkos village, Nicosia District, that is to say: —

The land shown as Plot Nos. 364 and part of 365 of the Government Survey plans No. XXI.51.W.1. and XXI.51.E.1.

## THE WELLS LAW.

CAP. 312 AND LAWS 19 OF 1951 AND 42 OF 1953.

#### Notice under Section 3a (2).

Whereas His Excellency the Governor, being satisfied that special measures for the conservation of water in the area set out in the Schedule hereto are necessary in the public interest, proposes to make an Order in respect of such areas under section 3A of the Wells Law:

Now, therefore, by the direction of His Excellency the Governor notice is hereby given that the particulars of the proposed Order shall be as set out in the Schedule hereto, and that a copy of the draft of the proposed Order

and every relevant map and plan may be inspected at the office of the Commissioner of the District in which the area affected is situated during office hours and free of charge during a period of fourteen days of the publication of this notice in the Gazette and that any person may, within the same period, by notice addressed to the Commissioner of the District in which the area affected is situated, object to the making of the Order.

## SCHEDULE. Defined Area.

In the villages of Yerolakkos, Paleometokho, Ayii Trimithias, Pano Dheftera, Kato Dheftera, Pano Lakatamia, Kato Lakatamia, Strovolos, Engomi and Ayios Dhometios, all in the District of Nicosia, the area within

the following boundary, that is to say :--

The boundary commences at the junction of the asphalt road leading from the village of Yerolakkos to Nicosia Airport with the Myrtou-Nicosia main road and proceeds in an easterly direction along the said main road to its junction with the Nicosia bye-pass, which junction is at the north-western corner of the Water Conservation Area, the boundaries of which are described in item 2 of Public Instrument 556 of 1951; thence southwards, south-westwards and south-eastwards along the western boundary of the said Water Conservation Area to its southwestern corner, which corner is at the north-eastern corner of Arkhangelos Monastery; thence south-westwards in a straight line to a junction of tracks with the road leading from the village of Ayii Trimithias to the village of Pano Dheftera, locality "Laxia tou Markou", which junction is at the south-western corner of the Water Conservation Area, the boundaries of which are described in item 1 of Public Instrument 556 of 1951; thence northwards along the western boundary of the said Water Conservation Area to its north-eastern corner, which corner is at the junction of a footpath with the asphalt road leading from the village of Yerolakkos to Nicosia Airport, locality "Kamarospilios", thence north-westwards along the said asphalt road to the point of commencement all which boundary is more particularly delineated in the Government Survey Plan, Serial No. 1740, a copy of which is deposited at the office of the Commissioner, Nicosia and Kyrenia, at Nicosia.
