## No. 481. THE SPECIAL COURT LAWS, 1955 TO 1959.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3096

MADE UNDER SECTION 18.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by the proviso to section 18 of the Special Court Laws, 1955 to 1959, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Special Court (Continuance) (No. 2) Order, 1959.
- 2. The Special Court Laws, 1955 to 1959, shall continue in operation for a period of six months from the 1st day of November, 1959, that is until the 30th day of April, 1960, and shall then expire unless continued in force for any further period or periods of six months by the Governorin-Council, by Order published in the *Gazette*, under the provisions of the proviso to section 18 of the said Laws.

THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 24th April, 1956, and published under Public Instrument No. 468 of 1956 (as amended by Public Instrument No. 859 of 1957) (hereinafter referred to as "the Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the Order, situated at Kato Kyrenia (hereinafter referred to as "the land"), subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for a period of six months;

And whereas by virtue of Public Instruments Nos. 1165 of 1956, 400 of 1957, 908 of 1957, 218 of 1958, 795 of 1958 and 234 of 1959, the Order was extended for periods of six months up to the 23rd October, 1959;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of one month:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which continues in force by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Continuace) Order, 1958), His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use of the said land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order for a further period of one month as from the 24th October, 1959.
