REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTIONS 26 (2) AND 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by sections 26 (2) and 43 of the Elections (President and Vice-President of the Republic) Law, 1959, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Elections (President and Vice-President of the Republic) (Amendment of the First Schedule) Regulations, 1959.

2. The First Schedule to the Elections (President and Vice-President of the Republic) Law, 1959, is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Form 6 and the substitution therefor of the following Form :—

THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CONTINUATION) LAWS, 1958 AND 1959.THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATIONS 64 AND 102.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Laws, 1958 and 1959, His Excellency the Governor, by this Order, orders as follows :—

1. Subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the use, for military purposes, of the land and property specified in the Second Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as “the land”) during the period ending on the 16th day of February, 1960, from the date of this Order is hereby authorised.

2. The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for such military purposes.

3. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of any interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

And further, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Defence Regulation 102, as set out in the said First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, His Excellency the Governor hereby revokes the Orders as set out in the Third Schedule hereto, without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

1. The land shall be occupied and used for military purposes only.
2. At the expiration of this Order the land shall be restored to the persons entitled thereto, free of any erection, structure or construction erected or constructed thereon after the making of this Order.
3. Compensation shall be paid to the persons having an interest in the land for its use and occupation under this Order.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

All that area of privately owned land situated at Katholiki quarter, Limassol town, that is to say:—

- (a) the property known as the "Sumach Factory, Limassol", comprising land, buildings, and all appurtenances thereto under plots Nos. 24/1/1 and 24/4/2 of the Government Survey plans Nos. LIV 58.1.III and I and LIV 58.4.I and II;
- (b) the land under parts of plots Nos. 23, 24/4/1 and 25/2 of the Government Survey plans No. LIV 58.1.III and I and No. LIV 58.4.I and II.

All which said area is more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Assistant Director of Lands, Cyprus, and dated the 26th October, 1959, a copy of which is deposited in the office of the Commissioner, Limassol.
