**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)  
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

**ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE  
REGULATIONS 61 AND 102.**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence Regulations 61 and 102, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946 (which continues in force in consequence of the Supplies and Services (Continuance) Order, 1958), I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Hire-Purchase and Credit Sale Agreements (Control) (Revocation) Order, 1958.
2. The Hire-Purchase and Credit Sale Agreements (Control) Order, P.I.: 1955, is hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done thereunder. 429/1955.
