ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 62.

Whereas by reason of the resignation of certain councillors of the Municipal Corporation of Nicosia (hereinafter referred to as "the said Corporation") the number of councillors of the said Corporation capable of acting has fallen below one-third of the total number of councillors as directed in accordance with the provisions of section 10 of the Municipal Corporations Law in respect of the said Corporation ;

And whereas in consequence thereof the council of the said Corporation is deemed to have expired :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 62 of the Municipal Corporations Law, His Excellency the Governor does hereby appoint a municipal commission consisting of the members whose names appear in the Schedule hereto to have all the powers and to perform all the duties of the council of the said Corporation which has so expired, until another council shall be elected in accordance with the provisions of the said section 62 and does hereby appoint Mr. D. M. Skettos, O.B.E., Administrative Officer, Ministry of Health, to be Chairman of the said commission during the same time and to have all the powers and perform all the duties of the mayor.
