THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CONTINUATION) LAWS, 1958 AND 1959. THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)

(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

Order made by the Governor under Defence Regulation 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 16th September, 1955, and published under Public Instrument No. 546 of 1955 (as amended by Public Instrument No. 92 of 1956 and No. 494 of 1959) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use for military purposes of the land and property set out in the Second Schedule to the principal Order situated at Kato Polemidhia and Chiftlikler Quarter, Limassol (hereinafter referred to as "the land") subject to the restrictions and conditions therein laid down for an initial period of six months;

And whereas by virtue of Public Instruments Nos. 219 of 1956, 968 of 1956, 251 of 1957, 817 of 1957, 167 of 1958, 1006 of 1958, 151 of 1959 and 494 of 1959, the principal Order was extended for further periods up to the 15th February, 1960;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period ending on the 15th day of May, 1960:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Defence Regulation 64 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Laws, 1958 and 1959, His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use of the land for military purposes subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the principal Order until the 15th day of May, 1960, as from the 16th day of February, 1960.
