## AMENDMENT OF NOTICE UNDER SECTION 6.

The notice made on the 7th January, 1960, and published as Public Instrument No. 14 of 1960, is hereby amended as follows :—

By the deletion of the words " Her Majesty's Secretary of State for War" from paragraph 3 of the said notice and the substitution therefor of the words " The Governor ".

2. The period mentioned in paragraph 2 of the said notice has, with the approval of the Governor, been extended for a further abridged period of 10 days commencing from the date of the publication of this notice.

2. The period mentioned in paragraph 2 of the said notice has, with the approval of the Governor, been extended for a further abridged period of ten days commencing from the date of publication of this notice.
