

**No. 142. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAW.**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3132**

MADE UNDER SECTION 124 (1).

Whereas by Order-in-Council No. 3121 published as Public Instrument No. 67 of 1960 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") authority was given to the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Councillors and Townsmen of the Municipal Corporation of Famagusta (hereinafter referred to as "the Municipal Corporation") to borrow from the Bank of Cyprus Limited the sum of forty thousand pounds (£40,000) subject to the terms and conditions referred to in the Order, for the erection of a Town Hall ;

And whereas the Municipal Corporation has now applied for the consent of the Governor-in-Council to utilize of the aforesaid sum an amount of ten thousand pounds (£10,000) for the construction and/or improvement of streets within the Municipal area :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 124 (1) of the Municipal Corporations Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

The Order is hereby amended by the substitution for sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph 1 of the following sub-paragraph :—

- "(c) the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Municipal Corporation:  
(a) for the erection of a Town Hall £30,000 ;  
(b) for the construction and/or improvement of streets £10,000."
