THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

Order MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.
Whereas by Order dated the 3rd October, 1956, and published as Public Instrument No. 964 of 1956, hereinafter referred to as "the Order", the Governor authorized the use of the land and property specified in the Order subject to the restrictions and conditions therein contained for military purposes during the period of six months commencing the 3rd October, 1956;

And whereas by virtue of Public Instruments Nos. 22 of 1957, 888 of 1957, 224 of 1958, 1013 of 1958, 230 of 1959, 483 of 1959 and 89 of 1960, the Order was extended for further periods up to the 2nd May, 1960;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land and property should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of three months:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Defence Regulation 64 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Laws, 1958 and 1959, His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use of the land and property specified in the Orders and subject to the restrictions and conditions therein contained for a further period of three months commencing the 3rd May, 1960.
