THE PUBLIC LOANS LAW. CAP. 247 AND LAWS 18 OF 1951 AND 58 OF 1954.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 3137 MADE UNDER SECTION 7 (1) (e).

Whereas the Maronite Archbishop of Cyprus has applied to the Loan Commissioners for a loan for the purpose of erecting buildings or otherwise improving the value of certain lands the property of the Maronite Church and situate in Cyprus;

And whereas the Governor in Council is satisfied that the purpose aforesaid is a purpose tending to advance the development of the Colony:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (e) of sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Public Loans Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to approve the granting of a loan not exceeding ten thousand pounds by the Loan Commissioners to the Maronite Archbishop of Cyprus for the purpose of erecting buildings or otherwise improving the value of the lands described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

Lands situated in the Ayios Andreas quarter in the town of Nicosia and held under the titles following:

Registration No. 729 Block 12 Plots 63/1, 63/2, 63/4, 64 and 65;

Registration No. 730 Block 12 Plot 63/3; and

Registration No. 731 Block 12 Plot 14.
