THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.

Whereas by Order dated the 9th January, 1956, and published as Public Instrument No. 16 of 1956, hereinafter referred to as "the Order", the Governor authorized the use of the land and property specified in the Order subject to the restrictions and conditions therein contained for military purposes during the period of six months commencing the 9th January, 1956;

And whereas by virtue of Public Instruments Nos. 640 of 1956, 1284 of 1956, 705 of 1957, 1112 of 1957, 1023 of 1958, 51 of 1959, 315 of 1959, 351 of 1959, 28 of 1960, 60 of 1960 and 91 of 1960, the Order was extended for further periods up to the 12th June, 1960;

And whereas the Governor is satisfied that the land and property should continue to be used for military purposes for a further period of six months:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Defence Regulation 64 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Laws, 1958 and 1959, His Excellency the Governor has authorized the use of the land and property specified in the Orders and subject to the restrictions and conditions therein contained for a further period of six months commencing the 13th June, 1960.

THE EMERGENCY (RESIDUAL POWERS) LAW, 1959.
THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER)
REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 2) 1959.

REVOCATION ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 4 (1) (a).
