PROCLAMATION UNDER SECTION 7.

HUGH FOOT,

Whereas by section 7 of the Elections (House of Representatives and Communal Chambers) Laws, 1959 and 1960 (hereinafter referred to as "the Law"), it is provided that the Governor shall, after the coming into operation of the Law, by proclamation published in the Gazette, appoint a date for the election of members of the House of Representatives and a separate date for the election of members of the Greek and Turkish Communal Chambers which shall be in each case the dates on which nominations of candidates shall be received:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the said section 7 of the Law, I, Hugh Mackintosh Foot, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Royal Victorian Order, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Cyprus, do, by this proclamation, appoint Thursday the 21st day of July, 1960, as the date for the election of members of the House of Representatives and Thursday the 28th day of July, 1960, as the date for the election of members of the Greek and Turkish Communal Chambers.
