THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CONTINUATION) LAWS, 1958 AND 1959.
THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) (CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

Order Made by the Governor under Defence Regulation 64. In exercise of the powers vested in him by Defence Regulation 64, as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, which continues in force by virtue of the provisions of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Continuation) Laws, 1958 and 1959, His Excellency the Governor, by this Order, orders as follows:—

1. Subject to the restrictions and conditions contained in the First Schedule to this Order, the use, for military purposes, of the land specified in the Second Schedule (hereinafter referred to as "the land") during the period of two years from the date of this Order is hereby authorized.

2. The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are entitled to do thereon or in relation thereto such acts as may be necessary for such military purposes.

3. The exercise of any right of way over the land and of any right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of any interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited during the period this Order shall remain in force.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

1. The land shall be occupied and used for military purposes only.
2. At the expiration of this Order the land shall be returned to the persons entitled thereto free of any erection, structure or construction erected or constructed thereon after the making of this Order.
