THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) LAW. CAP. 39.

THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) REGULATIONS, 1956 TO 1959.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Regulations 20 (h) and 53 (2) of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Regulations, 1956 to 1959, the Director of Commerce and Industry makes declarations in manner following:—

(i) grapes of the 1960 crop intended for export as table grapes shall be required before being harvested to be inspected at the place of growth by an inspector; and

(ii) the minimum requirements of maturity of sultana grapes shall be 9 degrees Beaumé except where in the opinion of the inspector other factors affect maturity.
